CONCIERGE RECOMMENDED ACTIVITIES WINTER 2024 - 2025

The Concierge team at the Stein Eriksen Lodge is pleased to welcome you for the winter season! The following are activities to consider, in addition to time on the slopes. Please note that some of these activities are up to an hour away from the lodge and may require transportation. Reservations are recommended and often required. Please visit the concierge desk for information and booking help.

Art Galleries – Park City’s art scene is thriving, offering a robust variety of unique art collections from local, national, and international, artists. On the last Friday of each month, 19 galleries open their doors for visitors and locals to enjoy light refreshments and to admire their latest art installations.

Bobsled Rides – Feel the rush as you speed down the Olympic track in a 4-person bobsled. A trained pilot will take you and two other passengers through 15 curves, reaching speeds up to 80 mph, and pulling close to 5 Gs of force. Billed as the most intense minute of your life, this ride will give you a very good idea of what Olympic bobsled athletes experience. Riders must be 16 with a valid driver’s license.

Cross-Country Skiing – A 20+ km cross-country ski center in the heart of Park City offers spectacular mountain views along one of three groomed loops. With 3k, 5k, and 10k+ loops, they are perfect for beginner, intermediate, and advanced classic or skate skiers. Heated underground parking, passes, equipment, and lessons, are all offered on-site. Private cross-country tours are also available.

Dog Sledding – Experience a once-in-a-lifetime dog sledding adventure. Taking a sled ride through some remote terrain is nothing short of exhilarating. The companies we work with have teams of beautiful huskies and other arctic breeds, some rescue dogs, all ready to take you on a sled guided by professional racers from all over the world!

Egyptian Theater - The Egyptian Theatre provides the community with high-quality entertainment experiences, both on and off its stage, in an historic and authentic atmosphere that is friendly, socially welcoming, and slightly irreverent. Ask our concierge team about what shows will be playing during your stay!

Fly Fishing – If you are fly fishing on Utah's famous Provo River you can be assured of a great day fishing. Experienced guides provide the equipment and everything you need to catch a trophy in the crisp Utah air.

Flying Eagle Zipline and Mountain Coaster – Located at Park City Mountain Resort, soar on the Flying Eagle seated zipline or take a ride on Utah’s longest Mountain Coaster as it winds through more than a mile of loops and curves at speeds up to 25 mph!

Glass Blowing Classes - Perfect for beginners and seasoned creatives alike, this hands-on experience with expert artisans allows you to create your own unique glass piece. Embrace your artistic side and take home a beautiful memento of your winter getaway!

Heli-skiing - Both intermediate and expert skiers can helicopter into deep powder caches in private or small groups. Skiers take about seven runs averaging 14,000 vertical feet of unforgettable powder.

Horseback Riding - Horseback riding through beautiful private land is offered year-round from outfitters located about 35-60 minutes from the lodge. Viewing the mountains, the wilderness, and maybe even wildlife in its natural habitat will create memories for everyone.

Ice Skating - Fun for the whole family. There are both indoor and outdoor options. Skate rentals are available, but make sure to dress warmly!

Park City Ghost Tours - This 90-minute walking tour of Park City includes stories about the town's history and the ghosts that still live here. Tours leave from Miner's Park on Main Street.

Park City Museum - After a \$9 million renovation and expansion, the Park City Museum offers a glimpse into our rough silver mining past. Located on Main Street in the heart of Old Town.

Sleigh Rides - Take a 30-minute tour of mid-mountain Deer Valley from right outside our back door. The small sleigh can accommodate up to six people, with a larger sleigh accommodating up to twelve.

Sleigh Ride to Dinner - This old-fashioned horse-drawn sleigh ride will take you from the base of the Park City Mountain Resort up the slopes to a mountain lodge and a western-style gourmet meal. Listen to entertainment and then enjoy your sleigh ride back.

Snowcat Skiing - An hour from Park City, enjoy 8-10 runs and 10,000 vertical feet.

Snowmobile Tours - Snowmobiling can offer a true back-country experience with over 100,000 acres of forested trails, huge meadows of seemingly bottomless powder, and breathtaking views from up to 11,000 ft. Trips can be arranged for one hour to all day.

Snowshoeing - Guided and unguided snowshoe tours are an excellent activity, whether you are looking for a scenic aerobic experience or just a peaceful walk in the woods. Some outfitters offer transportation, picking you up at the lodge and driving you to a location nearby.

Tubing - Soldier Hollow and Woodward Park City offer snow tubing and fun for the whole family. Day or night, the family can zoom down the hill and ride back up to do it again.
