



Imperial Hotel Blackpool – Dog Policy



At The Imperial, we know dogs are part of the family, and we're always pleased to welcome well-behaved four-legged guests for a seaside stay.

To help everyone enjoy a comfortable visit, from muddy paws to polished brogues, we ask that all dog owners follow the guidance below during their stay.

By bringing your dog to the hotel, you're agreeing to these house rules.

A Small Charge for Wagging Tails

Dogs stay for £35 per room, per dog, with a maximum of two dogs per room.

Where Dogs Are Welcome

Dogs are welcome in our dog-friendly bedrooms, the lobby, Number 10 Bar, designated restaurant seating areas, hotel ground and selected entertainment lounges.

Wherever they roam, dogs should remain on a short lead and close to their owner in all public spaces.

Dining With Dogs

Dogs are welcome to join you for breakfast in our designated dog-friendly dining areas.

We simply ask that they stay settled beside or beneath your table, remain away from the buffet, and keep all four paws firmly on the floor.

If breakfast excitement gets the better of them, our team may suggest moving to an alternative dog-friendly space such as the Derby Room or lobby, where available. Restaurant dining should be booked in advance.

Entertainment Lounges

Well-behaved dogs are welcome in our entertainment lounges at the hotel's discretion.

If your dog prefers to sing along louder than the act, we may ask that they take a short interval outside.

Clean Paws & Courtesy

Please always clean up after your dog and use the bins provided outside the hotel.

For everyone's comfort, dogs should be clean and dry before entering indoor public areas.

Leaving Dogs in Bedrooms

We understand owners know their dogs best.

Dogs may be left in bedrooms for short periods if you remain within the hotel, provided Reception is informed in advance, you remain contactable by phone, and your dog is likely to stay calm and content.

Please display the dog-in-room sign on your door whenever your dog is left unattended.

Dogs may not be left alone in bedrooms if you leave the hotel premises.

Should your dog become distressed or disruptive while alone, you'll be asked to return to your room promptly.

Good Dog Manners

We kindly ask that all dogs remain calm, friendly, and respectful of fellow guests throughout their stay.

Persistent barking, aggressive behaviour, roaming, jumping on furniture, or causing disruption may result in your dog being asked to leave public areas — and in serious cases, the hotel itself.

Damage & Responsibility

While we adore dogs, we do ask owners to take full responsibility for them during their stay.

Any damage, excessive cleaning, repairs, or disruption caused by your dog may be charged accordingly.

Other Pets

Our pet policy applies to dogs only.

Should you wish to bring another type of pet, please speak to us before arrival. Any non-dog guests are considered strictly by prior arrangement.
