SINGLE MALT SCOTCHES

SPEYSIDE

ABERLOUR A'BUNADH

Meaning 'the original' in Gaelic, A'bunadh has achieved a cult following among malt lovers.

ABERLOUR 16 YR

Golden syrup cake with liquorice, spices and honeysuckle. Aromatic apple and blossom notes with a balance of sourness and toffee. Deeply complex with a long finish.

THE BALVENIE – DOUBLEWOOD

This Speysider was initially aged in traditional oak casks before it was finished in casks which previously held Caribbean rum. Sweet vanilla forms a creamy palate with notes of apples and mangoes with a hint of orange in the background.

THE BALVENIE – CARIBBEAN CASK 14 YR

This Speysider was initially aged in traditional oak casks before it was finished in casks which previously held Caribbean rum, imparting some extra sweetness and warmth to the whisky. The fabulous result is a well-rounded whisky with notes of toffee, fruit and vanilla.

CARDHU 12 YR

Pioneered by Helen and Elizabeth Cumming, two of the earliest female distillers, this medium gold dram is known for its sweet aromatics and rich palate of orange, dark chocolate, delicate smoke and toffee.

CRAGGANMORE 12 YR

This Speyside is rich and spicy, with a very satisfying complexity and well- sherried backbone.

CRAIGALLACHIE 12 YR

Oodles of dynamic fruit notes with a distinctive current of smoke running through the middle.

DALWHINNIE 15 YR

Rated 95 points by Jim Murray. An underrated classic with just a hint of smoke. Lots of apple, pear and toffee.

GLENFARCLAS 17 YR

Full-bodied and rich, it fills and coats the palate with warming nutmeg, sherried fruits, cinnamon and mixed peels. A complex and sophisticated dram worthy of a taste!

GLENFARCLAS 25 YR

Gold Medal, Speyside Ultra Premium, Scotch Whisky Masters 2019. The epitome of long-aged sherried Speyside, smooth and silkily-textured, with rich, generous flavours of fruitcake, hazelnuts, dried fruit and a hint of dark chocolate and coffee.

GLENFIDDICH 12 YR

The world's number one selling single malt. Glenfiddich accounts for 35% of the world's single malt scotch sales. Enough said!

GLENFIDDICH IPA

First they made the beer and then aged it in barrels for a month. They then took the barrels to the distillery and aged the scotch in the same IPA barrels. A noble experiment.

GLENNFIDDICH XX

A collaboration of 20 Malt masters to pick 20 barrels and then marry them together for one stupendous single malt.

GLENFIDDICH 18 YR

An elegant nose, faintly sweet, scented with apple and wood. Glenfiddich 18yo is a robust and full-bodied single malt whisky, yet remains remarkably soft, rounded and long lasting.

GLENFIDDICH 21 YR - WINTER STORM

Finished for up to 6 months in ice wine casks from Peller Estates. Concentrated aromas of canned peaches, vanilla, and clotted cream. Silky on the palate. The finish is medium in length, slowly drying, but fruity to the end.

GLENFIDDICH 21 YR

GRAN RESERVA

Finished in Caribbean Rum soaked casks to give this well aged whisky notes of vanilla and toffee sweetness. Complex and smoky with a nose of leather and oak.

GLENGRANT 12 YR

Orchard fruits open it up, with orange and apple. A touch of pastry and a dusting of icing sugar. Touches of almonds last on the finish.

GLEN GRANT 15 YR

Rich and rounded with summer fruits and an abundance of fresh peach and honeysuckle. Creamy vanilla fudge underpinned by tropical notes of banana with white pepper. Spicy with a sandalwood and chilli dry finish.

GLEN GRANT 18 YR

Tropical bouquet of pineapple stalk, mango, lychee, and elderflower with hints of honey-roasted walnut and lemon peel. Soft, chewy salted caramel and milk chocolate unfurl on the palate with hints of baked plum and coriander.

THE GLENLIVET - FOUNDERS RESERVE

Delicate and complex, boasting scents of maple sugar and spice, and unfurls on the palate with a distinctly floral start that evolves into creamy vanilla, honey, sarsaparilla and baking spice.

THE GLENLIVET 12 YR

The world's second most consumed single malt. Grassy and light with floral notes.

THE GLENLIVET 15 YR

This lovely whisky is matured in French Limousin oak casks. The Limousin oak has a more open grain which lets the whisky get into the oak. Creamy rich and buttery on the nose with sweet fruits and delicate spice on the palate.

THE GLENLIVET 18 YR

Expect lots of honey and caramel from the get-go, winding into an interestingly dry and lingering finish entwining leather, cocoa, coconut and ginger.

THE GLENLIVET ARCHIVE 21 YR

The nose is full and rich with notes of sandalwood and pine with a long sweet finish. Highly regarded by the world's whisky lovers.

GLENROTHES 12 YR

Bright and intriguing nose of cantaloupe, apricot blossom, honey-baked walnuts, and vanilla bean. Smooth and rather light on its feet, lifted notes of green apple, sea minerals, and orange pith are dotted by tinges of toffee.

MACALLAN 12 YR - SHERRY OAK

Crisp and sweet with notes of sultanas and fresh apple blossom. One of the best out there in its age group.

MACALLAN 15 YR

Sublime and full, with a hint of cinnamon and rose. The taste is intense with rich chocolate with a hint of orange and raisin. The finish is lingering with a hint of chocolate, orange and dried fruits.

MACALLAN 18 YR

With maturation taking place in a combination of European Sherry seasoned casks, American Sherry seasoned casks and American ex-bourbon casks, this expression boasts bountiful notes of vanilla, dried fruit and wood spice.

MACALLAN - A NIGHT ON EARTH

Created from a selection of The Macallan's exceptional American and European oak sherry seasoned casks, along with American ex-bourbon barrels to deliver its rich, sweet shortbread-like character. A whisky referencing the rich Scottish delicacy traditionally gifted and eaten at Hogmanay, punctuated by festive notes of dried orange and spice.

MACALLAN HARMONY

Macallan has collaborated with renowned pastry chef Jordi Roca (from El Celler de Can Roca, which has three Michelin stars) on a smashing single malt with a decidedly chocolatey profile. Macallan whisky maker Polly Logan worked with Roca as well as Casa Cacao chocolatier Damien Allsop on this expression. Aged in sherry-seasoned European and American oak casks.

MACALLAN - RARE CASK

On the nose, soft notes of opulent vanilla and raisin give way to a sweet ensemble of apple, lemon, and orange. Balanced by a spicy quartet of ginger, cinnamon, nutmeg and clove. Oak resonates, timeless, polished and rich. Vanilla and chocolate lead the finale along with a light citrus zest. The finish is warming and woody.

THE SINGLETON 12 YR

The Singleton of Dufftown is a satisfyingly refined, beautifully balanced single malt that is naturally rich and smooth. It offers sweetness, crunchy nuts and smooth fruity richness.

TAMNAVULIN

A bouquet marked by freshly baked tarte tatin and vanilla pod, soon giving way to another level of charm as nuances of banana, caramelised orange and fresh ginger completes this tapestry of temptation. The palate

detects an avalanche of exotic flavours, glazed nectarines and frangipane, shortly enlightened by hints of sticky toffee pudding, demerara sugar and Seville oranges. Finish: Complex and rich. Fruit cake and overripe apricots.

HIGHLANDS

ABERFELDY 16 YR

This expression is finished in Oloroso Sherry casks. Raisins and cinnamon on the nose give way to butterscotch and caramel.

ANCOC 12 YR

Whisky Distiller of the year 2017. A delicate scotch with flavours of barley, spices and butterscotch-vanilla.

DALMORE 12 YR

Aged in Bourbon Barrels then half is transferred to Sherry barrels to finish. The two halves are blended back together for a fruit forward; sweet and rich whisky.

DALMORE 15 YR

Matured in Matusalem, Apostoles and Amoroso Sherry casks, it proffers all those winter spice, orange and chocolate notes characteristic of Dalmore Aroma.

DALMORE 18 YR

Matured in American oak and oloroso sherry casks. Fragrant with honey, vanilla, ginger, orange marmalade, and a hint of smoke. Relatively full-bodied, with flavors of tangy orange, marzipan, sherry, bitter chocolate, then oak. Licorice and citrus fruit finish.

DALMORE – KING ALEXANDER III

A sextuple-wood bottling. This auspiciously-named dram was matured in wine, Madeira, Sherry, Marsala, Kentucky bourbon and Port casks. Medium, well-rounded. Winter berries, spice, zesty orange. Liqueur finish.

DALMORE CIGAR MALT

Discontinued in mid-2009, causing quite an uproar indeed. The whiskies used for the reworked version were actually slightly older, but naturally still pair perfectly with a cigar.

DEVERON 12 YR

A core of butterscotch with waxy malt and apple pie. A sweet and delicious dram. Finishes with wood spice, vanilla and soft oakiness.

GLENDRONACH 15 YR

Baked pear and fresh pastry on the nose, leading to lovely flavours of honey and dried apricot. Tones of polished oak, fruit cake and hazelnut too. Fabulously balanced!

GLENMORANGIE SIGNET

There is said to be an element of some of the distillery's oldest and rarest stocks, ranging from 35 to 40 years, in this Highland single malt. Sweet, syrupy cinnamon and dry malt lead, followed by chocolate orange and a hint of lime.

GLENMORANGIE NECTAR D'OR

Sipping The Nectar d'Or is like sending your senses on holiday to a French pastry shop, where the air swirls with sweet scents, balanced by a soft drumbeat of spice.

GLENMORANGIE 10 YR - ORIGINAL

The backbone of the Glenmorangie whiskys. Fruity and thick with a long malty finish.

GLENMORANGIE 14 YR QUINTA RUBAN

A symphony of opulence. Marzipan, fresh apple and pear, milk chocolate, red berries, candied ginger, and praline on the nose build slowly, leading into a fruity, spiced palate. Finishes with hazelnut, spice, cigar wrapper, and oak.

INVERGORDON 18 YR - OLD PARTICULAR

Expect the familiarity of warmed almond pastry and maple nuts, the palate surprises you with banana, vanilla, and sweet spices. Combine all of the afore-mentioned into a satisfyingly

long, sweet finish. Not a single malt but a grain whisky using cereal grains and a column still.

LOCH LOMOND

Big and smooth with rich flavours of raisins, sultanas and luscious dates. A delicious vein of toffee brittle running throughout and a seductively light, peaty finish.

OBAN 10 YR SPECIAL RELEASE

Maturation in refill and new American Oak, then double maturation in ex-sherry and amontillado-seasoned casks, brings a mild nose with maritime salt and sea air. The creamy texture introduces a taste rich in sweet hints of wine-poached spiced plum, balanced by vibrant salt and spice, finishing with chili pepper. Rich, sticky sweetness sparkles through light smoke and salt.

ISLAY

ARBEG ARDCORE

Arbeg goes Ardcore! This limited edition expression from the distillery on Islay was made with roasted black malt, giving it an intense flavour profile, which is described as being “like biting a spiky ball” on the label.

ARBEG 10 YR

This is a big powerful whisky filled with smoke! Citrus and pear notes squeeze their way though but the smoke lingers for hours.

ARBEG'S THE WEE BEASTIE

The youthful age statement may take many scotch drinkers by surprise, but don't let double-digit bias prevent you from enjoying this exciting yet easy-drinking peat bomb. Salt water and smoke and sweet peat tussle on the nose, while vanilla, fresh berries, and ample nuttiness.

BOWMORE 12 YR

The peaty smokiness of this Islay favourite is balanced with lemon and honey.

BOWMORE 18 YR

Complex with soft fruit and chocolate balanced with a light smokiness. Bowmore refers to it as “Cosseted away in the finest hand-selected, oak casks and allowed to mature in its own sedate pace- one of the most remarkable, perfectly balanced single malt scotch whiskies of its kind.”

OBAN 14 YR

The distillery was built in 1794 offering the best of the highlands and combines it with the peaty flavours of the islands.

OBAN 21 YR

Limited release. Distilled in 1996 and bottled in 2018. Cask strength at 57.9% ABV. Intense smooth sweetness of orange on the nose that carries through on the palate. It changes in the glass with all kinds of flavours coming through.

OLD PULTENEY CASK 2007

The Maritime Malt, Old Pulteney is distilled in the port of Wick, Caithness. This expression was laid down in 2007 and matured for more than a decade in a single cask. No. 254 of 372 bottles.

BRUICHLADDICH PORT CHARLOTTE

Somewhat like eating a chorizo and roasted red pepper sandwich on the beach on a summer's day, but it retains the sweet freshness of the distillery character. There's dry smoke to start, becoming sweet with sugared almond on the finish.

BRUICHLADDICH LADDIE

Delicate aromas of honey and dried fruit combine with flavours of caramel and apricots with a light smokiness.

BUNNAHABHAIN

The taste starts with a light fruit and nut appeal that leads to a malty sweetness, finishing into a beautifully rich full-bodied experience.

CAOL ILA 12 YR

This expression is light and fresh with that distinctive Caol Ila smoke.

CAOL ILA 15 YR UNPEATED

This is the first of these unusual Islay malts to have been distilled this millennium, being filled into refill American oak hogsheads and refill European oak butts back in 2000. Warming and a little more toffee'd now with hedgerow greenery and fruit.

KILCHOMAN - MACHIR BAY

An excellent single malt Scotch from the isle of Islay. The distillers use whisky which has been matured in ex-bourbon barrels and Oloroso Sherry butts, resulting in a well-balanced flavour profile, with highlights of vanilla biscuits, light fruit and wafts of warm peat smoke.

LAGAVULIN 11 YR OFFERMAN EDITION

Lagavulin and Nick Offerman crafted this limited release as the perfect whisky to sip with the perfect steak. This single malt is matured for at least 11 years in heavily charred former bourbon and red wine barrels. The resulting flavour features hints of round red berries, a touch of briny saltiness, notes of vanilla and the signature Lagavulin intense peat.

LAGAVULIN 12 YR

This expression has enjoyed a dozen years of maturation in refill American oak casks before being bottled up at 56.5% ABV. The theme for the Special Releases this time was 'Legends Untold', and as such, this one features a lion with a flaming mane on the label!

LAGAVULIN 16 YR

Intense and smoky-sweet. Seaweed flavours with a big smoky finish. Double gold medal at the World Spirit awards 2017.

LAPHROAIG 10 YR

Very peaty with hints of honey and black pepper. A touch of water adds to the nuances of this whisky.

LOWLANDS

AUCHENTOSHAN 12 YR

An aroma of caramelized almonds and vanilla make this the cr me brulee of scotch.

AUCHENTOSHAN THREE WOOD

A Lowland single malt matured in three different casks, namely; Pedro Ximenez Sherry casks, bourbon casks and Oloroso Sherry casks. Rich. Liqueur cherries in dark chocolate, more sherried fruit, ripe dark forest fruits, like Black Forest cake.

BLADNOCH 10 YR

Scotland's Southernmost distillery. There distillery has been around for 205 years. The 10 year is floral on the nose with apples and

OCTOMORE 13.1

After five aged years in first fill ex-American oak casks, our Head Distiller has offered a unique twist in this 13.1, having gathered and recasked the spirit in 2021 into yet more fresh, first fill ex-American oak casks. This final injection of flavour, taken from the interaction between the spirit and the oak, offers additional flavours of dark toffee, coconut and vanilla

OCTOMORE 13.2

3.5 years in ex-American oak casks. Distilled in 2016 and malted to 137.3 PPM, the .2 series offers an alternative maturation, with a sublimely balanced ex-Sauternes profile. Fruity and floral from Bruichladdich's lochside warehouses before being re-casked into impeccable quality Sauternes casks. The pivotal role of the Sauternes casks would add 18 months of supercharged fruit. Melon, white peach, honeysuckle and coconut compliment the peat smoke of this heavily phenolic malt.

SCARABUS

A whisky for those with a curious mind and eye for detail. Bold and honest about its origins and just a little mysterious about everything else. From Arnahoe, the first distillery to be built on Islay since 2005. On the nose: really pleasant, gentle, sweet peat and citrus notes, heather honey, dried apricots, more floral flourishes in the distance. A very classic peated Islay.

wood spice enticing the palate. It finishes with a sweet mouthcoating that truly satisfies.

GLENKINCHIE 12-YEAR-OLD

Based close to Edinburgh. It has come to be known as the Edinburgh malt. You will pick up notes of lemon grass then a spicier lively finish.

LINDORES ABBEY

Lindores Abbey is the site of the first recorded distillation of scotch, in 1494, when King James IV commissioned Brother John Cor to make aqua vitae with eight bolls of malt. It was aged in ex-bourbon, ex-sherry, and STR ex-Burgundy red wine casks, and offers up a light yet rich flavour.

LOCH LOMOND 12 YR

This has a deep and fruity character of peach and pear with a vanilla sweetness and the characteristic hints of peat and smoke found in Loch Lomond whiskies.

THE ISLANDS

HIGHLAND PARK CASK STRENGTH RELEASE NO. 2

This shows a gigantic nose of windswept tidal pools, buttered toast with berry jam, preserved lemon, graphite shavings, and a whisper of campfire embers. The palate is massive as well and can easily accommodate some added water but even without holds its high octane impressively well.

HIGHLAND PARK 10 YR (ORKNEYS)

A subtle Sherry influence but balanced with a heathery smoke and a taste of sea spray.

HIGHLAND PARK 12 YR (ORKNEYS)

Salted lemons and honey with a taste of crunchy green apples followed by a smoky finish and silky mouth feel.

HIGHLAND PARK 15 YR - VIKING HEART

Exquisitely fresh with divine flavours of ripened red apple, fragrant herbs and earthy peat. Long and lingering on the finish with a smattering of subtle spice and smooth creamy vanilla.

HIGHLAND PARK 18 YR (ORKNEYS)

Ripe fruit and floral notes followed by soft smoke. Complex and delicious. A constant favourite amongst whisky lovers.

ISLE OF JURA 12 YR

Matured in a combination of American Oak and Olorosso Sherry casks. Flavours of chocolate fudge, nutty barley and pear come through.

JURA JOURNEY

It was aged exclusively in American white oak ex-bourbon barrels and bottled at 40% ABV. A tasty introduction to Jura's single malts.

JURA SEVEN WOOD

Part of the Jura range exhibiting 'sweetness and smoke.' This was aged in first-fill American oak barrels and finished in six different types of

French oak casks. Nutty on the nose, with freshly sawn wood, savory notes, and emerging peaches.

JURA PROPHECY

Named for the 18th century story of an old seer who, as she was being evicted from her home by the Campbells that dominated Jura at the time, foretold that the final Campbell on the island would have one eye and carry all of his possessions in a cart drawn by a white horse. That "prophecy" supposedly came true in 1938, when Charles Campbell, blinded in one eye during World War I, supposedly fell on hard times and had to leave the island in the state predicted by the seer. A slightly stronger peat taste to this Jura is very pleasant on the palate.

JURA 18 YR

Bold red fruits, toffee, crème anglaise and cinnamon. Warm spice and rich black forest fruit, bolstered by cooked raspberries and strawberries and a hint of chocolate. Matured in American White Oak ex bourbon barrels and enhanced by a finish in Premier Grand Cru Classé Bordeaux barrels

LEDAIG 10 YR (ISLE OF MULL)

Quite light and well-balanced. Medium-bodied and quite rich. There are notes of spice and smoke gathering above the charred oak. The peat is quiet and dry with a touch of black pepper and earth.

ROBERT BURNS

A single malt from the Isle of Arran distillery, celebrating the famed Scottish poet, Robert Burns. Fruity and rich, vanilla, pannacotta, apple and lime peel on the palate.

TALISKER DISTILLERS EDITION

Reflects the character of Skye; an island battered by wind and waves. Assertive peat smoke gives way to soft, sweet, fruity and roasted malt notes. Vanilla and chocolate flavours linger on a long finish.

TALISKER 10 YR (ISLE OF SKYE)

A fresh and fragrant nose. Through thick, pungent smoke comes sweet pear and apple peels, with pinches of maritime salt from kippers, seaweed.

TALISKER STORM

The name reflects the distiller's aspiration to enhance the maritime notes in this expression. Refill and rejuvenated casks have both contributed to its maturation. The nose is youthful but rounded, with brine, burning wood embers, vanilla, and honey.

INTERNATIONAL SINGLE MALTS

ALGRED GIRAUD HARMONIE (FRANCE)

Alfred Giraud has blended together three French malts for the Heritage expression. The spirit is then aged in three different cask types, with new French Limousin oak, American oak and casks which previously held XO Cognac.

AMORIK (FRANCE)

Woody notes blending with generous smoke and iodine, followed by some rich fruitcake and weighty spice giving complexity and balance. The finish is rounded with hints of succulent dark chocolate.

AMRUT FUSION (INDIA)

A blend of Indian and Scottish elements. Combines fruit, oak and vanilla with a touch of peat.

BRENNE (FRANCE)

This is very good, with honey, date, liquid chocolate, honeycomb, and some spice bite. But it's also very unusual, Brenne is released in single casks, so they vary dramatically. Aged in Cognac Barrels. Different but good.

THE ENGLISH 11 YR (ENGLAND)

This one was matured for just over a decade, with the 11 year old bottled up at 46% ABV. One for those who like a good balance of sweetness and spice in their glass.

LAIRD OF FINTRY (CANADA)

A small batch Canadian single malt. With forest notes of toasted oak and tones of vanilla, plum and raisins.

LAIRD OF FINTRY RUM CASK

The original Laird of Fintry finished in a rum cask which adds a lovely sweetness.

THE MATSUI MIZUNARA CASK (JAPAN)

Pale, fresh whisky, with lychee, pear, morning dew, apple, and a dash of salt and white pepper. It's honeyed and thick on the palate, with caramelized apples and tangerine, then bittersweet citrus attempts to dappen the pepper.

PAUL JOHN (INDIA)

Honey, spice and a liquorice aroma leads to a spiced, oak tinged honey flavour with peaty soot and copper. Smoked mocha brings on the finish of a bold whisky.

PUNI SOLE (ITALY)

The taste is distinctively sweet with strong notes of honey and blood orange that are counterpointed by creamy flavours of walnut and spicy oak.

PENDERYN SHERRYWOOD (WALES)

Aged in ex-bourbon barrels and ex-Oloroso sherry casks to bring out its rich fruity flavour. It starts with aromas of dark fruit and rich toffee mingled with green apples and hazelnuts. Sweet notes of toffee and sultana persist in the finish.

STAUNING (DENMARK)

The nose is very malty and toasty, with some smoke, leather, rubber, engine oil and chalky cut stone. The palate is sweet, with subtle parma violet, lavender and burnt rosemary florals. Next come umami notes of charred pork and mushroom, almost. It's big and mouth filling, with a heady perfumed smoke.

IRISH WHISKY

BUSHMILLS

Widely considered the oldest distillery in the world being granted a charter to produce whisky in 1608 by King James I.

GLENDALOUGH

A tiny craft distillery from the Wicklow mountains has a Kelowna connection. One of our own is a stakeholder in the distillery! Our own taste of Ireland.

GREEN SPOT

A non-age statement Single Pot Still Irish Whiskey comprising of pot still whiskeys aged between 7 & 10 years. The whiskey has matured in a combination of new bourbon and refill bourbon casks as well as sherry casks. Fresh aromatic oils and spices with orchard fruits and barley on a background of toasted wood on the nose. Full spicy body taste. A hint of cloves along with the fruity sweetness of green apples, rounded off with toasted oak. Followed by lingering flavours of spices and barley.

JAMESON BLACK BARREL

A special pot still whisky-heavy version of Jameson. Black Barrel has lots of first-fill bourbon and sherry casks in the mix, giving it a much richer flavour than regular Jameson, with a strong sherried note.

JAMESON IPA

The second release in Jameson Caskmates range, finished in casks that once held zesty IPA. The combination adds further layers of hop fruitiness to the whiskies already fruity character as well as a touch of citrus, floral notes and some balancing bitterness.

JAMESON

A blend of pot still and grain whisky. Then triple distilled to give the whisky its signature smoothness. Then aged in oak casks for four years. The largest selling Irish whisky in the world producing 31 million bottles annually!

PEAKY BLINDER

An Irish whiskey created by Sadler's Ales in Birmingham. Harking back to Brum's colourful 1920s' post-war past and the Anglo-Irish Peaky Blinders gang, it's a small-batch, triple-distilled, blended Irish whiskey, with balanced fruit and spice.

PROPER TWELVE

Founded by Connor McGregor, the name from the district of Dublin he grew up in. It's a blend of triple distilled single malt, Irish grain spirit, and matured in bourbon barrels. Aroma of charred oak, vanilla, honey with flavours of chocolate and green apple, with a soft finish.

REDBREAST 12 YR

This is a pot still whisky (single malt) which is triple distilled from malted and unmalted barley. Matured in Bourbon and then Oloroso Sherry casks. Spicy and fruity.

RED SPOT

The relaunched Red Spot is a 15 year old single pot still Irish whiskey, comprised of three different whiskeys aged separately then blended. One is matured in Oloroso sherry casks, one is aged in bourbon casks, and the final one is initially aged in bourbon casks before being finished in Marsala wine casks.

YELLOW SPOT

The Yellow Spot is a single pot still Irish whiskey which has been matured in three types of cask: American bourbon cask, Spanish Sherry butts and Spanish Malaga casks for a sweeter flavour. Aged 12 years.

ROE & CO.

Bottled at 45% abv without chill filtration. A blend of single malt and grain whiskeys matured exclusively in bourbon.

TEELING SMALL BATCH

Started in hand-picked oak casks and finished in rum barrels this is a very smooth Irish. This has been a family run distillery since 1782.

TULLAMORE DEW

Second only to Jameson in world-wide sales. The DEW on the label is the initials of Tullamore's former owner Daniel E. Williams who worked himself up from stable boy to the owner.

TYRCONNELL 16 YEAR OLD

A super single malt, double distilled at the Cooley Distillery using its unusually shaped copper pot

stills (small in size and long in neck) giving the whisky and copper lots of contact that resulted in a refined and layered spirit. This Tyrconnell was then bottled at 46% ABV, after it was aged for 16 years in ex-American oak bourbon barrels in a 200 year-old granite warehouse.

WRITERS TEARS

Only begun in 1999 this whisky has entered the market as a super-premium, triple distilled craft Irish Whisky.

BLENDS

BALLANTINES

First released in 1910. This whisky is a blend of 40 single malt and grain whiskies. Floral, citrus and vanilla come through.

BALLANTINES 17 YR

Full bodied with creamy vanilla. One of the best Scottish blends.

CHIVAS REGAL 12 YR

Layered flavours of brown butter and oatmeal give way to a slightly smoky finish.

THE FAMOUS GROUSE

Contains The Macallan and Highland Park scotches. Light and easy drinking.

THE GAULDRONS

"The Bay of Storms". This is a small batch blend of Campbeltown single malts. Salt and sweet cereal and gentle smoke make a wonderful combination of flavours.

JOHNNY WALKER BLUE LABEL

Legendary! An exquisite blend made from Scotland's rarest and most exceptional whiskies. Only one in every ten thousand casks has the elusive quality, character and flavour to deliver the remarkable signature taste.

JOHNNY WALKER BLACK LABEL 12 YR

The iconic Johnny Black has an unmistakably smooth, deep, complex character. An impressive whisky to share on any occasion, whether you're entertaining at home with friends or on a memorable night out. Best Blended Scotch 5-12 Years, Jim Murray's Whisky Bible 2017.

MONKEY SHOULDER

This unique blend of three Speyside Single Malts is aged in ex-bourbon casks which impart a smooth and mellow vanilla flavour into the whisky with hints of zesty orange, honey and spiced oak.

NIKKA - FROM THE BARREL

2018 Whisky of the year! Soft, sweet butterscotch and orange peel meet poached pears and stone fruits. Earthiness appears as dried autumn leaves, coffee, old oak, and tobacco.

NIKKA COFFEE MALT

Using the two Coffey stills at the Miyagikyo distillery, which were imported from Scotland to Japan in 1963, Nikka have produced a number of single cask single grain whiskies from time to time over the years. This, however, is their larger release of wonderfully exotic single grain whisky.

SUNTORY HIBIKI

This lovely Japanese blend has a nose of lychee fruit, a hint rosemary and sandalwood. Sweet candied orange peel round out the palate.

SUNTORY TOKI

A blended whisky from Suntory's three distilleries: Yamazaki, Hakushu and Chita. Toki has a different composition to another Suntory blend, Hibiki, as its main components are Hakushu single malt and Chita grain whisky.

CANADIAN WHISKY

BEARFACE

A relative new comer to the Canadian Whisky world. Bearface is aged 7 years in Bourbon barrels and then put into Red Wine barrels and finally finished in new Hungarian oak barrels.

CENTURY RESERVE 30 YR

A wonderful 30 year old Canadian whisky. Made from 100% corn. This single cask Canadian whisky, barreled in 1988, is a terrific find! Incredibly smooth yet complex. No longer available in stores.

CROWN ROYAL

A blend of 50 Canadian whiskies. This whisky was placed on the train to commemorate the visit of King George VI in 1939 wrapped in its iconic purple bag. Crown is rich and robust with hints of vanilla and oak.

CROWN ROYAL

NORTHERN HARVEST RYE

This whisky made headlines in 2016 when it won World Whisky of the Year in Jim Murrays Whisky Bible! A touch spicier with a higher rye content but still Crown Royal smooth.

FORTY CREEK DOUBLE BARREL

Corn, barley and rye whiskies are individually aged and then blended. Then they put the blend into once used bourbon barrels for another two years. A fine sipping whisky.

FORTY CREEK BARREL SELECT

Aged in old bourbon barrels and new American white oak. Features aromas of vanilla, apricot, honey, toasted oak, black walnut and spice.

GOODERHAM & WORTS

A blend of corn, rye, wheat and barley and bottled at 44.4% ABV this pours a golden/amber colour. The four grains all add their unique flavours to give this whisky wonderful notes of honey, toffee and stone fruit.

GIBSON'S 12 YR

Gibson's believes that character is only revealed with time; 12 years has resulted in this exceptional whisky. Rich with smooth and balanced flavours of caramel and spicy notes on a lengthy finish.

J.P. WISERS DELUXE

Wiser's signature blend. Caramel, dried fruit, toasted grains, vanilla and toffee all show on the palate. A Canadian iconic whisky since 1857.

LOT 40 RYE

Expertly distilled in small batches using only the finest locally sourced ingredients. By distilling in a single copper pot still, the result is a whisky that starts off earthy and woody tasting and then becomes full bodied and complex with a velvety vanilla oak finish.

PIKE CREEK

Stored in non-climate controlled warehouse Pike Creek barrels expand in the summer and contract in the winter driving the whisky into the wood giving the liquid a rich amber colour. Peppery notes and toffee on the nose give way to dried fruits on the palate.

WISER'S 15 YR

Deliciously smooth. This needs to be sipped and savoured to get a true appreciation of the full depth of its flavour.

WISER'S 18 YR

Multiple award winning Canadian whisky with an exceptionally smooth finish. Autumn florals, green apple, fresh pine, caramel and oak. Old enough to vote!

WAYNE GRETZKY

NO.99 RED CASK

Made from age old distilling practices and then finished in Gretzky Red Wine barrels. Honouring tradition with a touch of innovation.

CANADIAN CRAFT WHISKY

ALBERTA PREMIUM CASK STRENGTH

Warm, peppery rye spice is enveloped in maple and honey, supported by aromatic spicing of nutmeg and clove. With water, a wonderfully complex and balanced spirit emerges, undulating between cotton candy sweetness, black pepper spice, walnut praline, and new leather umami.

FORTY CREEK "VICTORY"

Commemorating Canada's victory in a battle fought in the War of 1812 where Forty Creek now distills whisky. Toasted oak staves were inserted into half of the fully matured whisky for 2 months. A strong maple nose dissolves into hints of fruitiness, while a sweet palate balances and restrains drying tannins. Fruity, creamy, with peppery spices.

INDIGENOUS SINGLE MALT

A local offering from West Kelowna! A distillers Blend by Colin Wertz. Aged in Port and Cognac barrels giving it a sweet aroma of Sultanas and strawberries, baking spice, black pepper, vanilla and a whisp of smoke.

ODD SOCIETY - PROSPECTOR

Prospector is 100% Northern BC rye, transformed into liquid, steam, and back again. It is then coaxed into new, heavily charred American White Oak barrels. With a heady nose of brown sugar, dried prune, vanilla and oak, this full-bodied rye melts on the tongue into light spice and stone fruit notes, leaving with a crisp, dry finish.

ODD SOCIETY - COMMODORE

Commodore honours tradition—beckoning back to a Scottish heritage—while proudly thriving in its West Coast berth. This refined spirit is distilled with 100% BC grown, malted barley. To that, it owes its distinctive peppery-sweetness, along with its dark fruit and tobacco notes. Gold Medal Winner.

OKANAGAN SPIRITS RYE

With a blend of 51% of our Coldstream Valley Rye, and 49% of our locally malted BC Barley, this three year-old hand-crafted Rye is aged in our custom American white oak barrels and then cut with our secret source of local artesian well water.

OKANAGAN SPIRITS

LAIRD OF FINTRY

Distilled in a copper pot still and using only malted barley, yeast and water the folks up in Vernon have crafted a fine single malt. Highly coveted and sold by lottery do not miss the chance to taste this fine whisky.

LAIRD OF FINTRY RUM CASK

Our local distillers have also recently produced a rum cask expression of the Laird of Fintry that we also carry with pride.

SHELTER POINT - THE COLLECTIVE

This unique whisky was a collective of 5 employees who each picked their favourite cask and blended them together! This whisky has distinct notes of vanilla and cinnamon and bursts of fruity flavour. Gold Medal Winner.

SPIRIT OF THE EL

A collaboration with Okanagan Spirits that went exceptionally well. We took their BRBN and added Quail's Gate Old Vines Foch Port to a cask. Then we aged it in an oak cask for 6 months. The port smooths out the whisky on your palate.

STILLHEAD B-WORD

This bourbon-style whisky has a mash-bill of 63% corn, 27% malt and 10% rye. It was aged for 3 years in new oak barrels, and then blended together to produce a beautiful, bold, b**chin' batch of 1100 bottles.

STILLHEAD RYE WHISKY

This whisky was a mash bill of 80% unmalted rye and 20% malted barley. It is a combination of two ex-bourbon casks which were aged for 2 years and finished for 1 year in small ex-maple syrup American oak barrels, and a small ex-port Hungarian oak barrel.

STILLHEAD MADEIRA CASK SINGLE MALT

This Small Batch Single Malt is finished in a Madeira Cask from the Cowichan Valley on Vancouver island. Bottled at 50% ABV and aged 3 yrs. A very well-done whisky for a small distillery. Try it you will like it!

AMERICAN & BOURBON

1792 (BOTTLED IN BOND)

This straight Kentucky bourbon is “from barrels all filled during the same season was bottled at exactly 100 proof.” The color of a rich wildflower honey. Warm and full, and more mouth-forward. The aromas are brought through in the flavour, with a layered maple and coffee-toffee sweetness and oak grounded by an earthy quality. The finish lingers, with a smooth yet spicy and savory buzz.

ANGEL'S ENVY

Named for the “angel’s share,” the portion that evaporates from the barrel during the aging process, this golden amber spirit is finished in Port barrels, which explains those juicy red-fruit notes that slide into the long finish.

ANGELS ENVY RYE

Angel’s Envy Rye Finished in Rum Barrels is genuinely unique and worthy of Master Distiller Lincoln Henderson’s legacy. The taste profile of rye whiskey was a perfect fit for a rum cask finish. After sampling over 100 rums to find the right flavour to complement rye whiskey, the team’s decision was unanimous. Angel’s Envy spends up to 18 months finishing in Caribbean rum casks, resulting in an immensely complex whiskey. The mingling of raw, spicy and earthy rye with the mellow sweetness of rum finishing creates an incomparably smooth and drinkable whiskey, even at 100 proof.

BAKERS BOURBON

Single Cask aged 7 years - 53.5% abv. A plethora of flavors opens up the palate, starting with slightly burnt caramel and spiced vanilla, which mix with green peppercorn and rye spice. Exploring more reveals a trace of sweet syrup. While the nose may hide the proof, the boldness of the sip is revealed here and helps to pull forward and exemplify all of the flavors.

BASIL HAYDEN'S BOURBON

Lively nose, good rye snap and spice, a bit of mint and oaky edge. Sweet, spicy, and easy to like, this is whisky without flaw, well-done and tasty, if not overly ambitious or challenging.

BASIL HAYDEN'S DARK RYE

With aromas of spice, tea and a hint of peppermint, Basil Hayden’s has a very pleasant light-bodied and gentle bite with a clean dry finish. A high amount of Rye grain in the mash bill lends a nice spiciness.

BASIL HAYDEN TOAST

Made with brown rice and finished in toasted barrels. Cereal grains with freeze-dried strawberries on the nose as well as toasted herbs, blueberries, and fruity bubble gum. The palate is creamy and light, with notes of strawberry yogurt, bitter chocolate, and burnt sugar. A syrupy finish brings custard, tiramisu, and caramel flan. It is atypical in its profile and at times light bodied, but demonstrates good constriction and drinkability.

BLACKENED

Using their proprietary BLACK NOISE™ finishing process, each batch of whisky is blasted with its very own Metallica playlist, curated by the band themselves. The low-frequency sound waves force the whisky to penetrate deeper into the barrel, extracting more caramel, honey and vanilla flavors from the wood.

BLANTON'S SINGLE BARREL

The Kentucky Derby bourbon. The first single barrel bourbon sold commercially. A deep, satisfying nose of nutmeg and spices. Powerful dry vanilla notes in harmony with hints of honey amid strong caramel and corn.

BOOKERS

Not for the weak. A very complex and intense nose that runs from oak, leather, caramel and hints of fruits continues on the tongue with a very pleasant burn that gives way to more leather, oak vanilla and spice. It’s a bourbon with a bite and should be bloomed with some water.

BREAKING AND ENTERING

Previously a bourbon, Breaking & Entering is now an American whiskey made with barrels of bourbon and rye that the St. George Spirits folks have “pilfered” (or as they would have you believe, sourced) from other distilleries, as well as their very own malt whiskey.

BROTHER'S BOND

65% Corn with 22% Rye to give it some spice. Finished with wheat and barley to smooth out the whole thing.

BUFFALO TRACE BC SELECT

Exclusive bottling for BC Liquor. There are aromas of honey, citrus and candied fruit notes. A quite complex whiskey with layers of rich oak, hints of spicy rye balanced with sweet citrus marmalade flavours. The palate is lively and lingers on the finish.

BUFFALO TRACE

This deep amber whiskey has a complex aroma of vanilla, mint and molasses. Pleasantly sweet to the taste with notes of brown sugar and spice that give way to oak, toffee, dark fruit and anise.

EAGLE RARE

Aged no less than 10 years. The nose is complex, with aromas of toffee, hints of orange peel, herbs, honey, leather and oak. Tastes of candied almonds and rich cocoa finish dry and lingering.

FOUR ROSES

Crisp yet soft and smooth. Fresh fruit, hints of pear and apple with a mellow, long and pleasant finish. Multiple Gold medal award winner.

GEORGE REMUS BOURBON

"Delicious nose of rich earthy dried fruits that builds on the palate with wonderfully balanced yet subtle pepperiness and heat. Rich oak gives added character and the length is long and extremely 'tasty'." 95 Points, International Wine & Spirit Competition 2022.

HEAVEN'S DOOR

Heaven's Door is a whiskey brand developed in collaboration with Bob Dylan. The bottles feature the iron gates created by Dylan in his studio. Elegantly perfumed with notes of toasted wheat, cereal, tree dust and marzipan. The palate is elevated and airy almost weightless.

HIRSCH THE HORIZON

While the nose showcases primarily grain aromas, including cracked corn and peanut shell, it also has notes of white pepper, dark cherries, brown sugar, and Hershey's chocolate syrup—a harbinger of things to come. The palate is a chocolate lover's dream, rich and tantalizing without heaviness. There's also mint, cinnamon, cashew butter, and well-

integrated oak; time and water bring out sweet orange. It finishes with milk chocolate, toasted nuts, and lingering cinnamon

JACK DANIELS HONEY

A blend of Jack Daniels whiskey and a unique honey liqueur of their own making. With hints of honey and a finish that is naturally smooth.

JACK DANIELS

Mellowed through 10 feet of sugar maple charcoal. It is only ready when their tasters say it is. Look, aroma and taste are all factors.

JACK DANIELS TRIPLE MASHED 1938

A blend of three Bonded whiskeys; American Malt, Rye and Tennessee Whiskey. This unique combination delivers a pleasant note of honey, malt, and soft oak, leading to a long-lasting well-rounded finish.

JACK DANIELS BONDED

Bottled-in-Bond at 100 proof, aged in select barrels for added depth and character. It delivers a big, bold Tennessee Whiskey with layered notes of caramel, rich oak, and spice giving way to a pleasantly lingering finish.

JIM BEAM BLACK

93 points, Ultimate Spirits Challenge 2018. The palate shows a subtle minty-ness that keeps the bold oak flavors from overwhelming and leads to a refreshing finish

JIM BEAM

Aged four years in American Oak barrels. A long family tradition has created one of the world's most popular bourbons. Sweet corn, caramel smoothness has a loyal following worldwide.

LEGENT

This is a very unique bourbon as it is a collaboration of two famous whisky makers. Fred Noe, Jim Beam's Master distiller and Shinji Fukuyo, Suntory's chief blender. The bourbon is aged for 5 years then finished in California wine casks and a second finish in Sherry casks.

LONGBRANCH

A bourbon with Texan connections and two filtrations. One of American white oak and another through Texas Mesquite wood. A collaboration with Mathew McConaughey and Wild Turkey Master Distiller Edie Russell.

KNOB CREEK

Rich, sweet, woody, full bodied, almost fruity. An unflinching balance of deep, old-style flavor with natural oak sweetness.

LARCENY

Crisp green apple, honey-baked walnuts, and brown sugar fill the nose, with succulent hints of blood orange and caramel. Silky smooth, with a mellow spice on the palate, shortbread cookies come to mind with a touch of burnt citrus peel.

MAKERS MARK

Red winter wheat is used to add to the corn to give this bourbon a very smooth taste. Woody oak, caramel, vanilla and wheat prevail on the nose with a balance of caramel, vanilla and fruity essences. The finish is smooth and subtle.

MAKERS MARK 46

Warm and inviting array of baking spices with plum pie, red apple skin, and black peppercorn on the nose. Oaky and incredibly soft on the palate; vanilla and confectionery cherries rush forward with hints of brown sugar and sweet spice on the finish.

MICHTERS SOUR MASH

Whisky Exchange Whisky of the year for 2019. First whisky made in the United States to achieve this honour. Its unique grain selection means it cannot be categorized as a rye or a bourbon. Its name comes from using some of the fermented mash from the previous batch as a starter for the new mash to be fermented.

OLD FORESTER

A soft and sweet aroma with a taste that softens quickly with hints of sweet corn and oak. Spicy with soft vanilla and light orange notes. Created in 1870 it is the only whisky to maintain production before, during and after prohibition.

OLD FORESTER 1920

The perfect proof. Rich in color, aroma, and flavor. It begins with powerful caramel, baking spice, chocolate, cherries, cinnamon, and toffee. Then nuance and complexity. Honey, jalapeño, rosemary, crème brûlée, malt, and fruit, from the spicy citrus of grapefruit to prunes and dried apricots.

OLD GRANDAD

In this glass is a liquid that shines a medium copper colour, with pleasantly sweet and spicy

aromatics. On the palate it is smooth and gently warm, with flavour notes of caramel, butterscotch, toasted pecan, dried apricot, nutmeg, grated ginger and cinnamon. The finish is clean and soft, with lingering candied flavours.

RABBIT HOLE

Rich, honeyed aromas of grilled corn cakes, walnut bread and a hint of mint. On the palate, full-bodied, moderately sweet and appealingly spicy, massively and dangerously quaffable.

RITTENHOUSE RYE

A storied past with a heritage that commemorates Philadelphia's famous Rittenhouse Square. Bottled-in-Bond, today's Rittenhouse carries the distinct, spicy flavor that is long associated with the brand.

RUSSELL 10 YR

Amber chestnut color. Mature aromas of oak, vanilla, toffee, and leather. A heavyweight bourbon with a huge flavor profile-oak, leather, and molasses, turning quite dry with a spicy, nutty finish that is very long and warming.

SAZERAC RYE

Versatile, crisp, and an ideal match for cocktails that includes orange liqueur as well as its namesake classic cocktail. Light aromas include vanilla and a touch of juicy citrus. Flavours run to bitter chocolate and black tea, finishing with a peppery tingle.

VIRGINIA BLACK

A collaboration between Brent Hocking (DeLeon Tequila) and Drake. Yes, that Drake. A blend of 2, 3, and 4-year-old bourbons. Smooth and silky with notes of caramel and some spiciness from rye grains.

WELLER

The original wheated bourbon whisky features an exceptionally smooth taste by substituting wheat for rye grain. This bourbon stands out with its burnt orange colour and softer flavor notes by avoiding the spiciness of the rye grain.

WILD TURKEY

This Kentucky Bourbon is aged up to six to eight years in "alligator charred" barrels, yielding honey-vanilla aromatics and mouthwatering, rounded maple and vanilla notes that close out with clove and cinnamon spark.

THE WISEMAN

Green apple candies, cinnamon stick, buttered popcorn, and sage on the nose. Ginger spice and sweet bubble gum notes intertwine on a creamy palate along with blackberry tart and cocoa powder. Candied raspberries on the finish matched with a sustained spice that lingers.

WOODFORD KENTUCKY DERBY

Woodford Reserve delivers a heavy aroma of rich dried fruit with a smooth, satisfying finish. Every year, Woodford Reserve, the Official Bourbon of the Kentucky Derby.

WOODFORD RESERVE

A clean brilliant honey amber colour. Rich, chewy, rounded and smooth, with complex fruits, cinnamon and cocoa. Toffee, caramel, chocolate and spice notes abound. Multiple gold medal winner. The distillery dates from 1812 and is a National Historic Site.

WOODFORD RESERVE DOUBLE OAKED

Uniquely matured in separate, charred oak barrels – the second barrel deeply toasted before a light charring – extracts additional amounts of soft, sweet oak character.

WOODFORD RESERVE MASTER

Collection is the take on crafting a spirit that exhibits the flavours of a classic beer style, in this case a rich, roasted malty stout. The result is the Fall 2021 Master's Collection release named Five Malt Stouted Mash, a rich and robust expression of Woodford Reserve Kentucky Straight Malt Whiskey.

YELLOW ROSE OUTLAW BOURBON

True to its name, this one breaks all the traditional bourbon laws. Made from 100% Texas yellow corn and aged in small American oak barrels right here in Houston. The 15-20 degree temperature swings in this part of Texas give our bourbon unique characteristics that can only be achieved here. In fact, our angel share is 15% per year, making our whiskey extremely rare and valuable to us.
