White Wine

- Hillville Road Chardonnay** £22.50
Australia 175ml £5.50
250ml £7.90
A juicy, medium bodied chardonnay showing white peach, cream and hints of pineapple. This wine has a generous creamy texture, sweet fruit and finishes with a lemon sherbet freshness.
- Viña Carrasco Sauvignon Blanc** £23.50
Chile 175ml £5.80
250ml £8.20
Bursting full with grass, elderflower and gooseberry flavours, this is a youthful and invigorating white.
- Crescendo Pinot Grigio** £24.50
Italy 175ml £6.00
250ml £8.50
A clean, fresh and fruity wine with lots of citrus and ripe pear flavours. Dry and crisp with refreshing finish.
- Mozzafiato Falanghina** £26.50
Italy 175ml £6.50
250ml £9.20
Light straw yellow with greenish reflections. It is fresh and fruity to the nose with notes of citrus, pineapple and white flowers.
- Kokako Sauvignon Blanc** £29.50
New Zealand 175ml £7.20
250ml £9.90
Gooseberry, pink grapefruit and tropical passionfruit with a citrus backbone. Fresh acidity with more mid-palate weight.
- Picpoul de Pinet, Ormarine Sea Pearl** £31.00
France
A snappy nose of lemon and lime fruit, with vibrant green apple. A racy wine with a lip-tingling finish.
- Toast & Honey Chardonnay** £35.00
USA
Delicious toasted vanilla notes and honeyed stone fruit and baked apple. Rich butterscotch and toasted oak on the palate, long flavorful finish.

White Wine

8. **Boschetto Gavi di Gavi DOCG** **£37.00**
Italy
Bright, clean apple and pear aromas on the nose, a citrus fresh palate, delicately herbaceous, touch of a mineral "twang" on the finish

9. **Ghost in the Machine Skin Contact Chenin Blanc** **£39.00**
South Africa
Aromatic with a smokey, nutty character on the nose. On the palate this wine is creamy, juice on entry with a subtle lime lingering finish.

10. **Henri Ehrhart Pinot Gris Element Terre** **£42.00**
France
Flattering with a discreet nose with notes of almonds and toasted hazelnuts. Smoky and roasted notes in the mouth. The finish in the mouth is complex and long.

11. **Craggy Range 'Te Muna Road' Sauvignon Blanc** **£49.00**
New Zealand
Typical aromas of passionfruit interwoven with kaffir lime leaf. The palate has succulence and sophistication. The finish is almost saline.

12. **E Bonneville Chablis** **£53.00**
France
Bright pale yellow in colour. Open nose of white fruits with a nice minerality offering complexity. The palate is well-balanced and the finish is lemon-flavoured and fresh.

13. **Pouilly-Fumé Pierre Brevin** **£59.00**
France
An inviting pale lemon-gold, with subtle aromas of grass, fresh fennel and gunflint against a backdrop of citrus. A ripe grapefruit palate with refreshing, zesty acidity.

14. **Dog Point Chardonnay** **£79.00**
New Zealand
This is a top Marlborough Chardonnay that genuinely rivals premier cru Burgundy.

15. **Puligny Montrachet: Domaine Bzikot** **£149.00**
France
Elegant and perfumed with notes of apricot, gooseberry and slate. Try it with grilled fish or a decadent seafood platter including scallops, oysters and prawns.

| | Raspberry and black cherry fruits on the nose that also emerge on the palate, complemented by a touch of spice. | 250ml £7.90 |

| | Soft and juicy Merlot with the perfect balance of red fruits, sweet vanilla oak and spice. | 250ml £8.50 |
| 18. | Wild Ocean Cabernet Sauvignon blend | £26.50 |
| | South Africa | 175ml £6.50 |
| | A richly-textured velvety wine with ripe plum and blackcurrant fruit aromas and a touch of vanilla oak. Soft and juicy. | 250ml £9.20 |

| | Silky smooth with lashings of blackcurrant, bramble and white pepper. | 250ml £9.50 |

| | Rich and complex, this wine is classic Rhône: a blend of Grenache, Syrah, Carignan, Mourvèdre and Cinsault. With plenty of intense red-fruit aromas and spicy nuances. | 250ml £9.70 |

| | Italy | |
| | Mouth-coating palate of dried prune, date and cherry, with notes of sweet spice and a lick of chocolate. Great structure from the good balance between the soft tannins and acidity. | |
| 22. | XM by Xavier Milhade, Bordeaux Supérieur AOC | £31.00 |
| | France | |
| | Deep ruby color, a nose of crisp red fruits. A superb liquorice attack. A concentrated, balanced wine with fine tannins like grilled coffee. | |
| 23. | Conde De Castile Rioja Reserva | £33.00 |
| | Spain | |
| | A complex wine that displays a harmonious blend of dried, stewed fruits and nuances of leather, vanilla and tobacco. | |
| 24. | Toast & Honey Pinot Noir | £35.00 |
| | USA | |
| | Zippy, red honey and berry compote. Red fruit dominant with cherry and raspberries on the nose, baking spices come through to join the fruit on the palate. | |
| 25. | Ghost in the Machine Malbec-Viognier | £42.00 |
| | South Africa | |
| | Herbaceous with hints of fynbos, rosemary and tobacco leaf, spiced or marinated red meats with a biltong coating. The palate bursts with plum and cherries - smokey. | |

Red Wine

26. **Roberto Sarotto Barolo DOCG** £59.00
Italy
Complex aromas of ripe red cherry fruit and sweet spices. The palate is full and velvety with a long complex finish. A great match for meat dishes, game and roasts.
27. **Craggy Range Pinot Noir** £69.00
New Zealand
Bright cherry with crimson hue. Aromatic dark cherry melds with subtle oak char. The wine is vibrant across the palate with red fruits and velvety tannins finishing savoury and dry.
28. **Charmes de Kirwan** £89.00
France
The rich and plummy second wine of renowned Margaux property Château Kirwan.
29. **Amarone Classico Costasera, Masi** £109.00
Italy
Prune, fig and chocolate are to name but a few. Every sip discovers another beautiful flavour from this brilliant producer.
30. **Vosnee Romanee Domaine Sirugue** £149.00
France
Three ideal Burgundy terroirs are behind this fruit-forward and complex wine. Excellent ageing potential.

Fortified Wine

31. **Fonseca Bin 27** £47.00
Portugal 100ml £6.40
A deep and youthful ruby colour, with an intense, fruity nose crammed with blackberry, cassis, cherry and plum aromas. The palate full-bodied and round, with a luscious, velvety texture.
32. **Manzanilla Pasada Pastrana NV, Hidalgo** £49.00
Spain 100ml £6.80
An intense nose of apple skins and nuts leads on to a palate characterised by classic notes of almonds, orange peel and a salty twang. A prolonged finish marks this out as a wine of real quality.
33. **Nectar' Pedro Ximenez** £49.00
Spain 100ml £6.80
On the nose rich aromas of fruits such as raisins, figs and dates accompanied by honey, syrup and fruit preserve. On the palate velvety and smooth with good acidity which alleviates the sweetness.

Rose Wines

34. **Bel Canto Pinot Grigio delle Venezie Rosé** £23.00
Italy 175ml £5.70
250ml £8.00
Pale pink, rich in red fruits and floral on the nose.
Fresh, crunchy taste, with a good structure.
35. **Pescadero Point White Zinfandel Rosé** £25.00
USA 175ml £6.10
250ml £8.70
This vibrant fruity rose is bursting with juicy
strawberries, raspberries and watermelon on the
palate, giving way to a sweet and moreish finish.
36. **Le Bois des Violettes Rosé** £27.00
France 175ml £6.60
250ml £9.40
Fresh and crisp, with very subtle strawberry fruit and
a dash of sweet spice. This is a structured and
vibrant wine.
37. **Henri Ehrhart Rosé** £39.00
France
Pale pink colour, the wine seduces by its aromatic
intensity with notes of violets and cherries. The
palate is lively, light and refreshing with fruity and
slightly vegetal notes.
38. **Roseblood d'Estoublon Rosé** £49.00
France
Elegant, with a distinctive mineral freshness, in which
notes of apricot and peony express themselves
freely on a citrusy canvas, ending in elegant
tension.

Desert Wine

39. **Elysium Black Muscat Half Bottle** £39.00
USA 100ml £10.80
Virtually black in colour, with a rose-like aroma, very
intense on the palate and full of fantastic rich
velvety fruit. One of the few wines that can stand up
to chocolate puddings. Or try it poured over ice
cream for the ultimate after-dinner treat!
40. **Castelnau de Suduiraut, Sauternes, Half bottle** £47.00
France 100ml £12.80
With seductive aromas of fragrant orange blossom,
spices and fudge. The smooth initial taste develops
into soft sweetness on the palate backed by the
delicate aromas that are found on the nose.
41. **Royal Tokaji 5 Puttonyos, Hungary** £79.00
Hungary 100ml £16.00
A medium amber colour with a nose of orange
peel, figs and cinnamon. The sugar on the palate is
well-balanced by the fine acidity, leading to a
clean, refreshing finish.

Prosecco & Sparkling Wine

42. **Apericena Prosecco 20cl** **£9.50**
Italy
Delicate and aromatic with fine bubbles. This wine carries lots of fresh peach, pear and an elegant zest.
43. **Apericena Prosecco** **£29.00**
Italy
Delicate and aromatic with fine bubbles. This wine carries lots of fresh peach, pear and an elegant zest.
44. **Fiammetta Prosecco Rosé** **£29.00**
Italy
Light pink in colour, with typical copper hues. The bouquet is intense. Delicate hints of acacia flowers, typical of Glera variety, blend with violet and raspberry notes from Pinot Nero.
45. **Graham Beck Brut** **£39.00**
South Africa
An inviting nose full of lightly yeasty aromas. The palate offers fresh, gentle lime fruit delivered with a fine mousse, giving the wine a creamy texture on the finish.
46. **Graham Beck Brut Rosé** **£39.00**
South Africa
Pale silvery pink, with aromas of raspberry and cherry, with some subtle mineral hints. Bright acidity and fine mousse balance well with the ripeness of the crushed berry flavours.
47. **L'Extra par Langlois Brut, Crémant de Loire** **£39.00**
France
Langlois-Chateau is owned by Bollinger. It's made in the same 'traditional method' as Champagne. But because it's from the Loire Valley, it's a fraction of the usual asking price.

48. **Champagne Haton Réserve Brut** **£69.00**
France
Straw yellow colour with a beautiful sparkle. Fine, abundant bubbles. On the nose there are delicate fragrances of white peache and orange blossom.
49. **Pol Roger Réserve NV** **£109.00**
France
Pol Roger's historic underground cellars are 33m deep and average particularly low temperatures. They thus provide an environment uniquely suited to slow fermentation, and are responsible for this Champagne's famously super-fine mousse.
50. **Laurent-Perrier Rosé NV** **£139.00**
France
stylish strawberry fruit, full of vivacity and easy-drinking charm. A wonderfully refreshing aperitif, it also works well with a variety of dishes.
51. **Dom Perignon, Gift Box** **£299.00**
France
Exceptional depth, rich texture and great ageing potential characterises this iconic Champagne from Moët et Chandon, named after the Benedictine monk who pioneered Champagne.

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
