31. Fonseca Bin 27 Portugal

A deep and youthful ruby colour, with an intense, fruity nose crammed with blackberry, cassis, cherry and plum aromas. The palate full-bodied and round, with a luscious, velvety texture.

Manzanilla Pasada Pastrana NV, Hidalgo Spain

An intense nose of apple skins and nuts leads on to a palate characterised by classic notes of almonds, orange peel and a salty twang. A prolonged finish marks this out as a wine of real quality.

33. Nectar' Pedro Ximenez Spain

On the nose rich aromas of fruits such as raisins, figs and dates accompanied by honey, syrup and fruit preserve. On the palate velvety and smooth with good acidity which alleviates the sweetness.

34. Bel Canto Pinot Grigio delle Venezie Rosé \$23.00 Italy 175ml \$5.70 Pale pink, rich in red fruits and floral on the nose. \$250ml \$60.00

35. Pescadero Point White Zinfandel Rosé \$25.00 USA 175ml \$6.10 This vibrant fruity rose is bursting with jujey 250ml \$8.70

This vibrant fruity rose is bursting with juicy strawberries, raspberries and watermelon on the palate, giving way to a sweet and moreish finish.

37. Henri Ehrhart Rosé £39.00 France

Pale pink colour, the wine seduces by its aromatic intensity with notes of violets and cherries. The palate is lively, light and refreshing with fruity and slightly vegetal notes.

38. Roseblood d'Estoublon Rosé £49.00 France

Elegant, with a distinctive mineral freshness, in which notes of apricot and peony express themselves freely on a citrusy canvas, ending in elegant tension.

Desert Wine

39. Elysium Black Muscat Half Bottle £39.00 USA 100ml £10.80

Virtually black in colour, with a rose-like aroma, very intense on the palate and full of fantastic rich velvety fruit. One of the few wines that can stand up to chocolate puddings. Or try it poured over ice cream for the ultimate after-dinner treat!

40. Castelnau de Suduiraut, Sauternes, Half bottle £47.00 France 100ml £12.80

With seductive aromas of fragrant orange blossom, spices and fudge. The smooth initial taste develops into soft sweetness on the palate backed by the delicate aromas that are found on the nose.

41. Royal Tokaji 5 Puttonyos, Hungary £79.00 Hungary 100ml £16.00

A medium amber colour with a nose of orange peel, figs and cinnamon. The sugar on the palate is well-balanced by the fine acidity, leading to a clean, refreshing finish.
