High tea meets high art as Sofitel Sydney Wentworth marks the Archibald season

In addition, there is a blueberry choux that captures the gentle fall of jacaranda petals and a Wentworth cheesecake tart with almond frangipane to showcase the textured beauty of an ever-evolving garden.

Bringing together French hospitality with a modern twist, an artisan cart arrives at your table, unveiling savoury delights in a personalised and theatrical moment. With a glass of Pommery Champagne in hand, guests can select from curated cheeses, freshly baked baguettes, smoked salmon, charcuterie, and house-made quiches.

"The Archibald season offers our pastry and culinary team an opportunity to create something unique and special, drawing inspiration from Sydney's vibrant artistic community," said Sam Panetta, General Manager at Sofitel Sydney Wentworth. "Each intricately designed pastry invites guests to savour an artistic experience that is as beautiful to the eye as it is delicious."
