recent study published in Scientific Reports found that people who frequently visit bodies of water, or what experts call "blue spaces", report less mental distress and better overall well-being. This likely comes as no surprise to many of you. We are all familiar with the initial calming feeling when seeing the vastness of Lake Superior, particularly if you've been away for a while. The sounds and sights of a body of water this large give us a sense of being near something greater than ourselves.

Lake Superior contains 10% of the planet's fresh surface water



There have been around 350 shipwrecks recorded in Lake Superior



Lake Superior is, by surface area, the largest lake in the world



There is enough water in Lake Superior to cover all of North and South America with water one foot deep



The deepest point in the lake is 1,333 feet



There are 78 different species of fish that call the big lake home



The largest wave ever recorded on Lake Superior was 31 feet high



The average underwater visibility of Lake Superior is about 8 meters, or 27 feet, making it the cleanest and clearest of the Great Lakes. Underwater visibility in some spots reaches 30 meters



The average temperature of Lake Superior is 39 degrees Fahrenheit



Angry Trout in Grand Marais

The Angry Trout Café was established in a special location on the Grand Marais harbor in 1985 by Barb LaVigne and George Wilkes. Throughout the last 35 years, the restaurant has become well known as one of the go-to places for freshly caught Lake Superior fish, locally grown organic produce, as well as their commitment to sustainability and supporting local vendors.

The Angry Trout sold to long-time employees, Jessy Goble and Elliot Doherty Noyce, in April of 2023. The new owners intend to run the café very similarly to the prior owners, which includes being an important and generous part of the Grand Marais business community.
